Hi Joel:

I was very pleased to receive news of a new chapter inducted into SAR; that's exciting news, to say the least. I continue to support any efforts that will lead to a stronger fraternity and I am always available to assist in any way possible.

The times spent as a Sigma Rho of the Delta Xi chapter, two terms as the Exalted Ruler of LIDC, and my three years on the SBC have only furthered my desire to see the generations of Jewish teens experience the friendship that I had with Michael "Duke" Carmel and Harold Weisberg be replicated. My last convention was in 1969, in Boston, where I served as the assistant convention director. My only regret is not being named as a recipient of the Gleaming Eye honor.

Although I was against the war in Vietnam, after graduating from Hofstra University I was inducted into the United States Army as Second Lieutenant assigned to the 3rd army in Fort Hood Texas (after training in Fort Knox, Ky.) and was promoted as a captain

in the 142nd rainbow division, 69th infantry. I served two deployments in Soo bee, Lai Que, and finally at Da Nang airbase as a company commander in an armor division. After the military, I became a buyer for the largest women's shoe company in Saint Louis and rose to the 3rd Vice presidency: all due to my leadership training in SAR.

So anything is possible and the stimulus for success was my time in our fraternity.

With ever-growing evidence of antisemitism, we must strengthen our resolve to keep SAY for Jewish teens only. My motto is simple: Never again! Think not only of the holocaust but of the thousands of years that have wrought the jew horrible conditions and unspeakable discrimination.

Once again my congratulations to the active fraternity: start with one and add as many.

Applicants may be YOU, your CHILD or your GRANDCHILD.

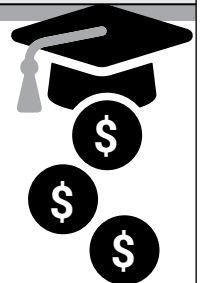
Children or Grandchildren applying must be by birth or legal adoption.

Looking back I now see the significant impact SAR had on my life! When I was 12 I met Michael Kushner at Hebrew School who introduced me to Michael Koff and Ted Fisher in ETA (Huntington Valley) ... then introduced these guys to Jay Abovitz in Southampton. And Xi was born. Through different SAR Brothers I was exposed to the early world of mobile disc jockeys at parties (I think 1974'ish). I wanted to make money and dropped out of Temple University to start 800-The-Pros in 1978, which performed at 155,000 weddings when I sold in 1991. This happened because of SAR.

I was then asked by the Dean and Chairman of Temple University to start the Center for the Advancement and Study of Entrepreneurship, which was an honor cause I was a drop out. And then cofounded Wharton's Entrepreneurial Network and Fairleigh-Dickinson's Entrepreneurial Center (eventually Ursinus'). Moved on age 35 to cofound the nation's first formal private equity/angel investor group with the CEO of the nation's first public venture capital firm (Pete Musser, Safeguard). Managed to lose money and waste time in a wide variety of angel investor deals, then co-founded a specialty finance firm 20 years ago purchasing personal injury claims and funding attorney's cases, and about 15 years ago co-founded www.ExecutiveLeadersRadio.com. This all happened because of SAR! Now 65, I've been married for 25 years (Sandy) and am blessed with Victoria (19). My father once told me "I hope you have a kid like you." Well, I do!
