# Advisors Needed for Growing SAR Today

## Dear Brothers,

To further our vision and ensure the growth of Sigma Alpha Rho, we recognize the need to establish additional chapters. To help lead this endeavor, we have decided to take the next step by hiring one- or two-chapter advisors. We believe this move will play a pivotal role in facilitating the anticipated growth of our fraternity.

Since there has been no activity of the active fraternity from 2016 until 2022, we do not have recent Alumni that normally could fill these positions. The Alumni Associations Re-activation Committee is looking for help from our Alumni to identify potential candidates for these positions. Efforts are being made to identify SAR Alumni in their 20's and 30's who might be interested in these part-time paying positions.

While we ideally seek Sigma Alpha Rho alumni, we have encountered challenges in finding younger brothers interested in this

opportunity. We will continue to explore that option; however, we are open to hire non-SAR candidates who have the requisite experience with Jewish youth groups, camps, college fraternities and teachers.

The position is part-time with about 5-10 hours per week needed to successfully meet the goals and objectives. The majority of the time will be remote, meeting with chapters vis Zoom, making phone calls and mentoring the chapter leaders. There will be some in-person meetings with the chapter and chaperoning when necessary.
